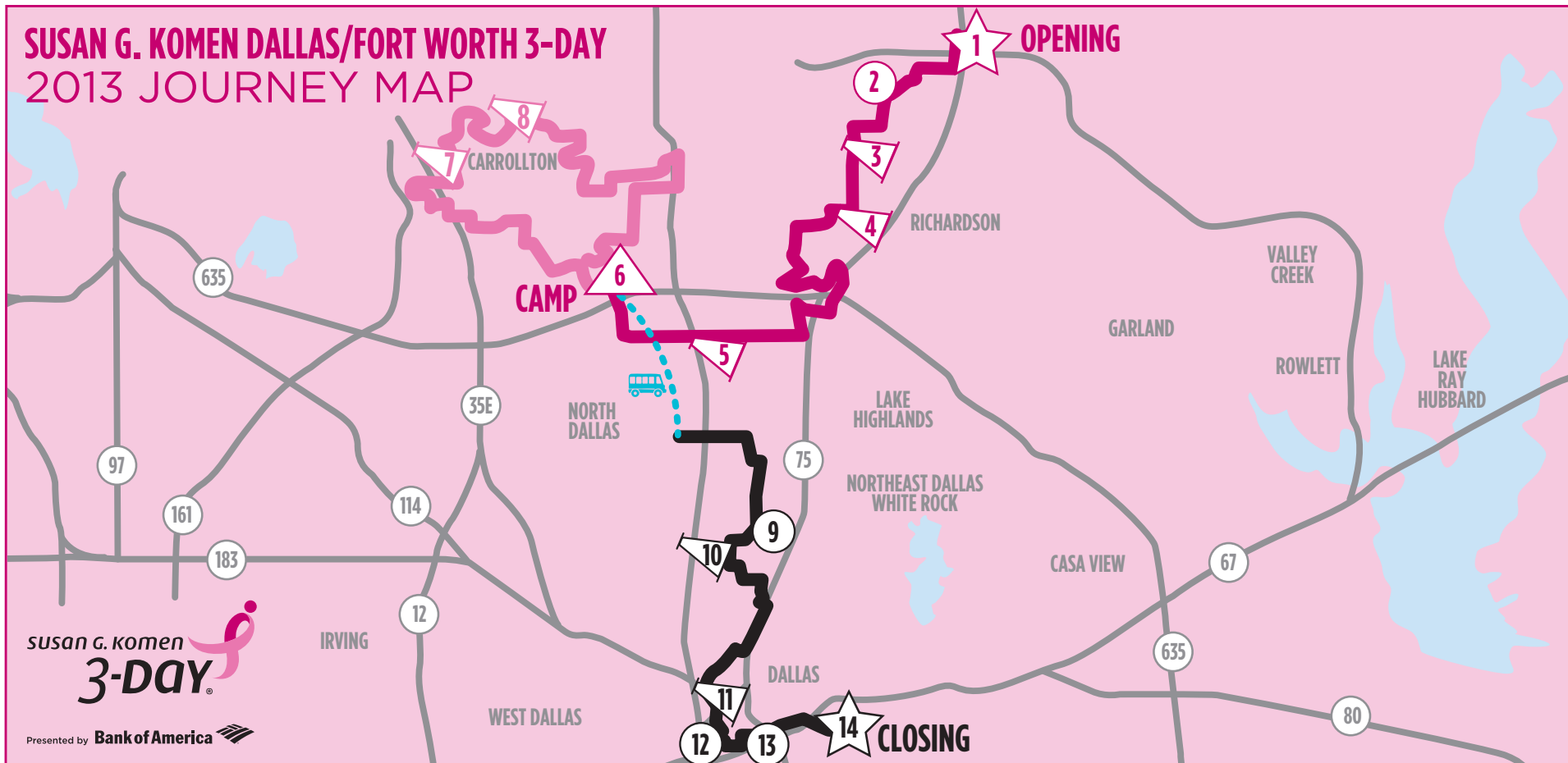


SUSAN G. KOMEN DALLAS/FORT WORTH 3-DAY 2013 JOURNEY MAP

12. Kennedy Memorial !

Dedicated in 1970 and designed by architect Philip Johnson, it is a "cenotaph," or empty tomb, that symbolizes the freedom of John F. Kennedy's spirit.

13. Pioneer Plaza !

This 4-acre downtown park commemorates the trails that brought cattle to market. It features life-sized bronze statues of 49 longhorn steer and 3 cowboys on horses.
